Our Goal and Purpose is, to provide students of all ages with biblical instruction and principles that will aid them in their Christian walk, witness and development.***

CHILDREN/YOUTH Classes

Promise Patch PreK:

For children ages 3-5*. The overall goal of this class is to help introduce children to Jesus at a level where they can understand. Emphasis is placed on group learning by using variety of activities. *Must be potty trained.

Primary Class:

For children enrolled in 1st and 2nd grades. The goal of this class is to teach students how the bible and the teachings of Jesus apply to their personal lives and their salvation.

Junior Class:

For children in grades 3-5. The class is interactive using role playing and other teaching methods that illustrate the biblical lesson and applications to students' daily lives.

Junior High Class:

For youth in grades 6-8. Believing that this is the age when youth attempt to distinguish fact from fiction, this class is geared to help students transition from thinking of God as mythical to understanding that God is real.

Senior High Class:

For youth in grades 9-12. This class attempts to help teenagers find or exercise their identity in Christ.



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ADULT Classes

Ambassadors for Christ/Seekers of God's Truth:

This class is geared towards adults who desire to learn how to apply the scriptures and teachings from the lesson to everyday life situations. It is assumed that each student is thoroughly prepared, has studied the lesson and reflected on it daily prior to Sunday.

Seekers of the More Excellent Way

The class offers diversity in methods of teaching from lecture to discussion. Within each approach the scriptures are presented, practical applications are made and a discussion/question format is implemented.

Wisdom Seekers

This class is an intermediate study designed for adults who have a basic knowledge of Scripture. Students in this class desire to expand their knowledge of God's Word and grow deeper in their relationship with the Lord.

Ezra's Flock

This class takes a verse-by-verse or passage-by-passage exposition of the Scriptures. Strong emphasis is placed on the historical and cultural setting of the passages being studied.

Barber Shop (Men's Class)

The class is composed solely for men who desire to study from a Christian male perspective. Men are encouraged to discuss the Word of God with fellow brothers using life experiences and scripture application. The class is presented in a generalized discussion format.

Nathan's Network:

The class emphasizes the study of how God impacts the outcome of events occurring in one's life. The teaching style combines discussion, lecture and provides opportunity for students to facilitate.
