We are now in a spiritual state of emergency. In this emergency, Pastor Gallmon is requesting that we pray once every day. In our prayers, he has asked that we lift up those who have this virus, those who will be diagnosed with the virus and to pray for the eradication of this virus. In Jesus name, amen!

Concerning this weekend, all rehearsals scheduled for Saturday March 21 are cancelled. This includes all choir rehearsals, praise dance and step. All scheduled committee or board meetings will be transitioned from in-person meetings to video or teleconference call. On Sunday March 22, there will be no Sunday school classes. However, there will be 10:00 am worship service. Pastor Gallmon is encouraging that all members participate in the service by viewing it via the Facebook Live web-stream. If there are those who have a desire to attend in person and who are not considered vulnerable, there is a limited opportunity to do so. In compliance with federal guidance and based on our Sanctuary square footage, there can only be accommodations for thirty (30) members. To be included in the thirty, please call the church office during business hours at 612.588.4709 and leave your name with Mrs. Gallmon. Business hours are Monday through Friday 9:00 am to 5:00 pm.

Finally, in preparation for Communion Sunday two weeks from now, (Sunday April 5), be planning to prepare communion for your household. As you think ahead to your next trip to the grocery store, make note to purchase some grape juice and if you don't

already have it, some bread or crackers. We will take the Lord's Supper together virtually.

Pastor Gallmon thanks you for your prayers, for your input and guidance and for your love. He encourages us to remember, *if God be for us, who can be against us.*
