  - o Malta, Netherlands, Norway, Poland
  - o Portugal, Slovakia, Slovenia
  - Spain, Sweden, Switzerland
  - Monaco, San Marino, Vatican City
  - Most countries except the UK and Ireland
- <u>Frail Congregants over the age of 65, or any persons with underlying conditions</u> including: cancer, diabetes, kidney, lung or liver disease
- Anyone who has been <u>exposed to a person with known Coronavirus</u>
