





Growing in our faith requires continuing education. We will create a congregation that's excited about learning. Twice a year we will hold an "Increase My Faith" seminar series. These series will feature several 4-6 week class offerings that the Fellowship family can register for. The classes will expand on ideas introduced in sermon series while also providing an opportunity for relationship building. Most of all, these courses will supplement the work being done in our Sunday School classes and Bible Institute.

Most importantly, we'll make an intentional effort to welcome our neighbors in North Minneapolis. Our "Door to Door" campaign will reach each household on the 20 blocks closest to our church. We'll also bring back our long overdue neighborhood block party.

Next Generation Investment

Jesus teaches us that the kingdom of God belongs to the next generation (Mark 10:14). Our greatest responsibility as a church is to create an environment that fosters the faith and well being of young people. To that end we aim to do the following:

• Create Youth Flex Space

- We will completely renovate the lower level of our CFF building
- Create a fun and inviting space for our children
- Dedicated to the memory of Deacon Cleveland Staley
- The new space will house worship offerings for 3 age groups: Elementary, Middle, and High School students
- The space will also to allow us to develop dynamic after school programs:
 - Tutoring for all ages
 - Coding lessons for middle and high schoolers

Launch a Campus Ministry

- One Sunday per month we will charter a bus from U of M to FMBC
- We'll also make sure students are fed after church
- We'll initiate connections with mentors & potential employers
- Recommit our support for Cityview Community School
- Provide a Music Ministry Option for FMBC Young Adults to use their gifts in worship



Key Performance Measures

- Annual Baptisms Increase from 3 to 20
- Average Monthly New Family Class
 Completions Increase from 2 to 10
- Average Weekly Attendance Increase from 150 to 500
- Average Weekly Volunteer Participation -Increase from 35 to 100
- Average Weekly Giving Increase from \$15k to \$35k
- Average Weekly YouTube Views Increase from 750 to 2,000
- Annual Mortgage Reduction Increase from \$180k to \$240k
